Chapter 43: QUALIFICATION AND REGISTRATION OF VOTERS

17 V.S.A. § 2121. Eligibility of voters

§ 2121. Eligibility of voters

Any person who, on election day:

- (1) is a citizen of the United States;
- (2) is a resident of the state of Vermont;
- (3) has taken the voter's oath; and
- (4) is 18 years of age or more

may register to vote in the town of his residence in any election held in a political subdivision of this state in which he resides. (Added 1977, No. 269 (Adj. Sess.), § 1; amended 1997, No. 47, § 11.)
